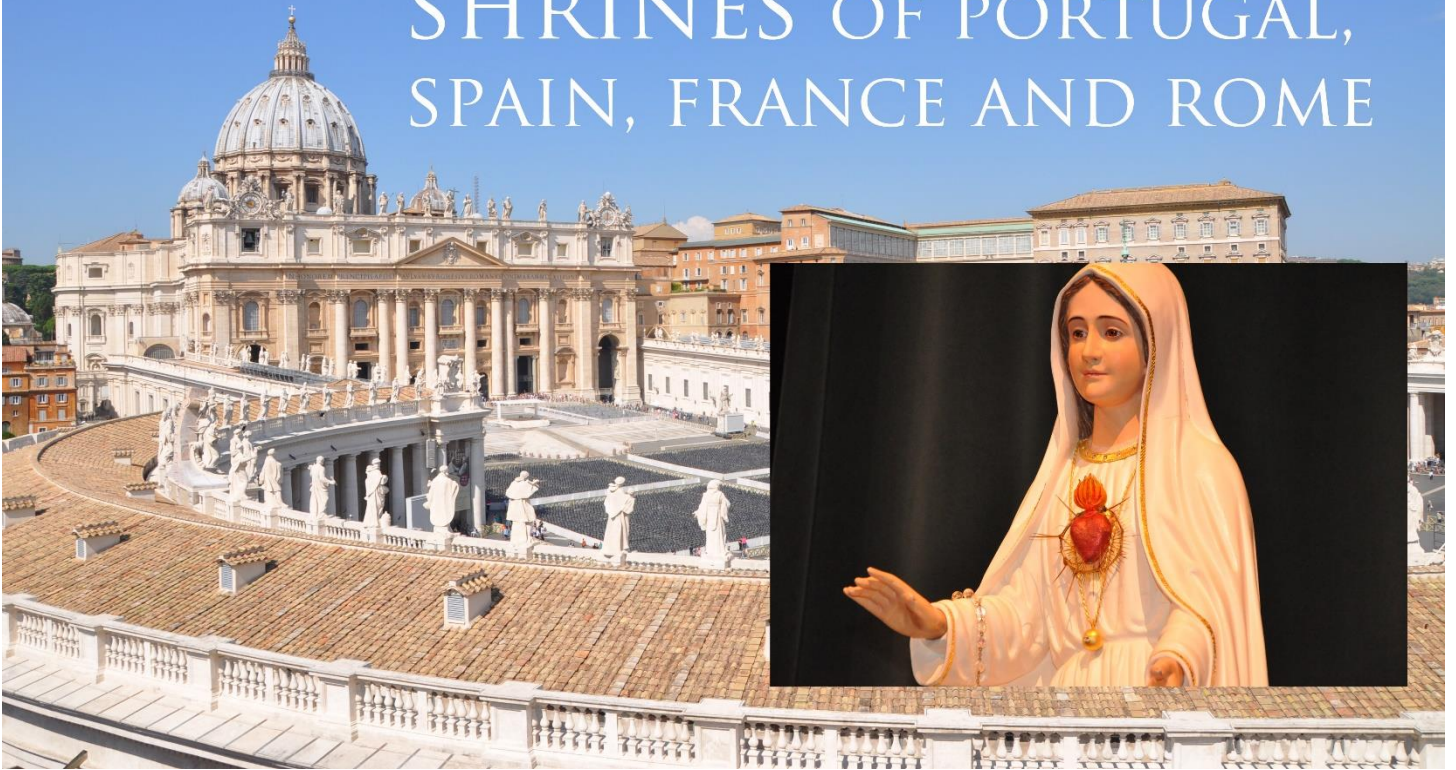

Planned Itinerary*

DAY 1: Sunday, May 29, 2016 – Vancouver-Frankfurt

Depart Vancouver on afternoon overnight flight with Lufthansa to Frankfurt, Germany. (D, M)

DAY 2: Monday, May 30, 2016 - Frankfurt

Arrival in Frankfurt and transfer to our overnight hotel. We will celebrate Mass in the airport chapel sometime in the afternoon of this day. (No meals after the flight are included this day).

DAY 3: Tuesday, May 31, 2016 – Frankfurt to Fatima

Transfer to Frankfurt airport for flight to Lisbon, Portugal. After luggage pickup meet our guide and driver to travel to Fatima with a stop in Santarem for Mass and lunch. Continue to Fatima, the site of one of the world's most famous Catholic shrines. This evening, why not join the Rosary and candlelight procession at Our Lady of Fatima Basilica. (B, D)

DAY 4: Wednesday, June 1, 2016 – Fatima

This morning, after Mass at the Sanctuary, time to visit Our Lady of Fatima Shrine with the tombs of the visionaries and the Chapel of the Apparitions, made famous by the Virgin Mary's appearance to the three shepherd children – Francisco, Jacinta and Lucia beginning on May 13, 1917. This afternoon, time to explore on your own, or join a guided optional excursion. (B, D)

DAY 5: Thursday, June 2, 2016 – Fatima–Braga–Santiago de Compostela, Spain

Journey north this morning and stop in Braga, one of the oldest Christian cities in the world and nicknamed the "Portuguese Rome." Visit the Bom Jesus do Monte (Good Jesus of the Mountain) Sanctuary and see the unique zigzag stairway that is dedicated to the five senses – sight, smell, hearing, touch and taste- and the three theological virtues – faith, hope and charity. Cross into Spain and head for Santiago de Compostela. Mass and Rosary. (B, D)

DAY 6: Friday, June 3, 2016 – Santiago de Compostela

This morning, visit St. James' Cathedral, Santiago de Compostela which has been known throughout history for the key 9th century pilgrimage route, the Way of St. James. Later, explore on your own or join an optional excursion to Cabo Finisterre, where pilgrims complete their walk and burn their robes. Mass. (B, D)

DAY 7: Saturday, June 4, 2016 – Santiago de Compostela-Burgos

Today, travel to Burgos, the historic capital of Old Castile. Your visit takes you to the magnificent Cathedral, a masterpiece of Gothic architecture and the burial place of Spain's national hero, El Cid. Mass. (B, D)

DAY 8: Sunday, June 5, 2016 – Burgos-Loyola-Lourdes, France

Travel through the Basque region toward Lourdes. En route, celebrate Mass at the 17th century Sanctuary of Loyola, built in honor of St. Ignatius of Loyola, founder of the Jesuit order. See its spectacular dome and main altarpiece, built in marble and jasper. Cross the border into France and on to Lourdes, home to

another of the world's most famous places of pilgrimage. Join the nightly rosary and candlelight procession for a memorable experience. (B, D)

DAY 9: Monday, June 6, 2016 – Lourdes

Today's guided walking tour includes the Grotto where the Virgin Mary appeared to St. Bernadette in 1858. Visit Our Lady of Lourdes Shrine, Bernadette's birthplace and her family home. The afternoon is at leisure to further explore this little market town that became a world-renowned pilgrimage site during the 19th century. Join those waiting in line for the afternoon opening of the healing, cleansing baths. Mass. (B, D)

DAY 10: Tuesday, June 7, 2016 – Lourdes-Toulouse-Rome

Today, leave Lourdes for Toulouse, where we will board our flight to Rome. Arrive in Rome late afternoon. Mass. (B, D)

DAY 11: Wednesday, June 8, 2016 – Rome-Subiaco

This morning we go to St. Peter's Basilica to attend the Papal Audience. Afterwards, travel to Subiaco to visit St. Benedict's and St. Scholastica's monasteries with a local guide. Mass. (B, D)

DAY 12: Thursday, June 9, 2016 – Rome

Enjoy Globus' unique guided sightseeing, including inside visits to the highlights of religious and ancient Rome: the Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel with Michelangelo's ceiling paintings and the Last Judgement, with monumental St. Peter's Square and Basilica. The rest of the day at leisure. Mass. (B, D)

DAY 13: Friday, June 10, 2016 – Rome

Today sightseeing with a local guide. Visit St. Sebastian Catacombs, St. John Lateran, Scala Santa, St. Mary Major Basilica. Rest of day at leisure to explore the city on your own. Maybe take in some of the non-religious sites, e.g. the Colosseum, Spanish Steps, etc. Mass. (B, D)

DAY 14: Saturday, June 11, 2016 – Rome-Frankfurt-Vancouver

A group transfer will be provided to the airport for our flights home. (B, M)

CANCELLATION POLICY:

A notice of cancellation must be received in writing. Penalties will be to the fax, e-mail, or postmark date. The \$1,000 deposit includes a non-refundable amount of \$250. For cancellation after the March 18 deadline (when final payment is due), cancellation fee of 50% of the total price until May 1. For cancellation between May 1 and day of departure, 100% of total price is non-refundable. Cancellation protection travel insurance is highly recommended and can be purchased at time of deposit.

Should the chaplain be unable to participate in this trip, every effort will be made to secure a substitute. Regardless of the participation of the chaplain, the tour will proceed as scheduled on the dates listed. By signing this form to participate in this tour, you agree that the terms of the cancellation penalty will be binding upon you regardless of whether the chaplain is able to participate.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PASSPORT:

A valid passport is required for this tour and must be in your possession at all times during the tour. If you do not have a passport, apply immediately as the process can entail a long wait. Remember to check the expiration date of your passport before booking (certain countries require a minimum of three months passport validity from the return date of your trip). At the time of reservation, OC-Travel requires a copy of the inside page of your passport (showing your name and photo). Important: we recommend that you take two additional photo copies of your passport - leave one at home with your emergency contact while keeping the other with you on the trip, separate from your actual passport (this will assist you in the case of your passport being declared lost or stolen).

AIRFARE:

Your airfare includes roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers via coach bus. This is an air inclusive tour package which means your airfare is quoted inclusive of all fuel, taxes, and fees. When traveling with group air, the air carrier for your flight will be announced in your final travel documents. Due to the airlines restrictive group reservation terms, group airfare reservations are often difficult to coordinate. Seats are limited and may not be available on every flight or departure date. The number of connecting flights, length of layovers, and all conditions of air travel cannot be guaranteed and may change before departure. We ask you to be reasonably flexible. For seat requests, please note that group seats are assigned at the discretion of the airline. Specific seat requests cannot be guaranteed. If you require specific seats, OC-Travel suggests you book the tour package as "land-only" and arrange for your own air travel.

LAND-ONLY PACKAGE:

If you wish to purchase your own airfare, you may wish to consider purchasing a land-only package. With this option, you are able to secure your own preferred

air arrangements. If you decide upon this option, you are responsible for meeting the group at the specified time and location. If you miss the group at the agreed meeting point, land-only travelers are responsible for the cost and arranging for their transfers to and from the airport.

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

OC-Travel highly recommends the purchase of cancellation insurance. OC-Travel is not responsible for any loss incurred by the traveler due to a cancelled flight or other means of transportation. PAYMENT TERMS:

OC-Travel asks for prompt payment on the requested dates in order to keep our prices low and to meet our deposit schedules with our suppliers for this tour. Please see the reservation form for the payment schedule. OC-Travel accepts cheque, e-transfer, Visa and MasterCard for payment.

ITINERARY:

The itinerary presented is tentative and subject to change. It represents what we are planning for you. However, it is subject to confirmations from many organizations. Because of changes in local schedules, we may need to alter specified events, dates, or venues, to better fit the overall plan. OC-Travel reserves the right to alter or cancel the itinerary, at OC-Travel services' sole discretion, as it deems necessary for the comfort, convenience, or the safety of the tour.

LUGGAGE:

Baggage is at owner's risk throughout the tour. Checked baggage is limited to ONE bag per person. Details will be in your final travel documents. For most airlines, the one checked bag is limited to 50 pounds and 62 inches (length + width + height). You may also bring a small carry-on bag that will fit under or above your airline seat and later in the coach bus. You must be able to carry your own luggage. We recommend luggage on wheels.

DRESS CODE:

Our journeys focus on the needs of our faith-based travelers. In visiting world famous spiritual sites, take note - there is often a dress code. Covering of knees and shoulders is required. Absolutely no shorts or shoulderless tops are permitted at many religious sites, including the Vatican Museums.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

This tour includes a significant amount of walking. Moderate physical activity is expected on a walking tour. This includes stairs and uneven walking surfaces. Motor coaches are often not permitted to pick up or drop off in front of major attractions. Some of the most unique sightseeing includes accessing locations that restrict motor coaches, especially in historic city centres. Bring appropriate walking shoes. Travelers must be medically and physically fit. The tour is not wheelchair accessible.

PARTICIPATION:

OC-Travel services reserves the right to decline to accept or retain any participant on any of its tours if, in its sole discretion, it deems any such participant as being detrimental to the tour and the well-being of the other travelers. In the event that any participant is removed from a trip, OC-Travel's only obligation is to refund to that person that portion of the payment allocable to unused services.

GRATUITIES:

Gratuities for main guides and drives (except for optional excursions) are included. Not included are gratuities for any local guides (at your discretion), as well as free-will offerings given at each Mass which is celebrated in a church.
