Sunday, September 14, 2014 – Vancouver, Rome
Depart Vancouver on flights to Rome, Italy.

Monday, September 15, 2014 – Rome, Amalfi Coast
Arrive at Rome airport, meet our bus escort, and depart by private motor coach for the breathtaking drive along the Amalfi coast. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure to take in the sights and sounds of the town of Praiano, overlooking the sea. Check into hotel before the welcome dinner. Overnight in Praiano. (Dinner)

Tuesday, September 16, 2014 – Amalfi Coast
After breakfast, enjoy a beach day on the Amalfi Coast – the stunning southern shore of the Sorrentine Peninsula. We will begin our day by driving in private motor coach along the famous seaside highway to visit the towns of Amalfi, and Ravello. Visit to the famous Cathedral in Amalfi which contains the relics of St. Andrew the Apostle. Optional swim in the sea. Lunch. Return to hotel for relaxing afternoon in the hotel or on the beach. Optional swim in rooftop pool at hotel. Overnight in Praiano.

Wednesday, September 17, 2014 – Pompeii

Breakfast. Early departure for Pompeii. Pray before the miraculous image enshrined inside the exquisite Pontifical Shrine of the Blessed Virgin of the Rosary of Pompeii, located in the shadow of Mount Vesuvius. Mass at the shrine. Opportunity for splendid Neapolitan lunch. Guided tour of the ruins of Pompeii, the Roman city destroyed by Mt. Vesuvius in 79 AD. Dinner on our own. Overnight in Praiano.



Thursday, September 18, 2014 – Capri

Breakfast. Today we will take a boat ride to the famed Isle of Capri to enjoy a day in the Mediterranean sunshine. Enjoy the scenery while seeing the most striking seaside views in Italy – Capri - rising high above the sea on almost-vertical faces of cliffs, made of volcanic stone tufa. Lunch on our own in this mini paradise. Savor the local cuisine while shopping for local pottery and regional wine. Taste the local limoncello. Overnight in Praiano.

Friday, September 19, 2014 – Naples

Breakfast, departure for Naples to enjoy the annual festivities of the patronal saint's feast day, St. Gennaro. Explore this former royal city, with its breathtaking view of the bay and volcano, Mt. Vesuvius. Guided walking tour of the city. Lunch on our own in Naples – birthplace of pizza.

Free time to explore together the pedestrian streets of this busy city where there are various bars and cafes to taste the local food and drink. Overnight in Praiano.

Saturday, September 20, 2014 – Rome, Vatican City

After breakfast, depart in private motor coach for Rome. Along the way, enjoy the beauty and nature of the Roman countryside. Check into hotel in Rome. Visit St. Peter's Basilica, the largest church in Christendom, and tomb of St. Peter the Apostle. After lunch, private bus tour of Christian Rome and visit to the three major basilicas of the Eternal City: St. Mary Major, the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran (cathedral church of Rome); St. Paul's Outside the Walls, which houses the tomb of St. Paul; Basilica of Santa Croce to see the relics of the passion of Christ; Scala Santa to see the holy staircase that Christ walked up. Group dinner. Overnight in Rome. (Dinner)

Sunday, September 21, 2014 – Rome, Vatican City

Mass and breakfast. Leisurely walk along the Tiber River to the Vatican for the papal audience. At 12:00 noon the Holy Father will appear at the window of his private apartment. He will give a brief catechesis and greet the crowds gathered in the square



below. He will pronounce the apostolic blessing. Lunch. Guided walking tour through downtown Rome making stops at piazzas and fountains. Dinner on our own. Overnight in Rome.

Monday, September 22, 2014 – Rome, Vatican City

This morning, optional celebration of early Mass in St. Peter's Basilica. Visit the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel, where you will view some of the most inspiring works of visual art, including Michelangelo's magnificent frescos of the Last Judgement and Creation. Lunch on the Borgo Pio. Afternoon is at your leisure for souvenir shopping and exploring on your own. Possibility to visit the top of the dome of St. Peter's Basilica. Group dinner. Overnight in Rome. (Dinner)

Tuesday, September 23, 2014 – Rome

In the morning, a private tour of Ancient Rome, the Roman Forum, and Coliseum. See the splendor of the Ancient Empire come alive. Admire the ruins and remnants which have survived the passage of centuries. Lunch break. Afternoon is open for your leisure. Optional Rome by night walk at dusk to see the fountains and piazzas of the city under the lights. Overnight in Rome.

Wednesday, September 24, 2014 – Rome

Papal General Audience in St. Peter's Square. The pope addresses all present with a brief catechesis. The pilgrims from around the world greet him. Concludes with Our Father in Latin and papal blessing. Lunch in the neighborhood of the Vatican. The rest of the afternoon is at your leisure. Celebratory farewell dinner. Overnight in Rome. (Dinner)

Thursday, September 25, 2014 – Rome, Vancouver

This morning, transfer to Rome airport for return flights home.

For cancellation on the day of departure and after, 100% of total price. Cancellation protection travel insurance is highly recommended and can be purchased at time of deposit.

Regardless of the participation of Pavel Reid, the tour will proceed as scheduled on the dates listed. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PASSPORT:

A valid passport is required for this tour and must be in your possession at all times during the tour. If you do not have a passport, apply immediately as the process can entail a long wait. Remember to check the expiration date of your passport before booking (certain countries require a minimum of six months passport validity from the return date of your trip). At the time of reservation, OC Travel requires a copy of the inside page of your passport (showing your name and photo). Important: we recommend that you take two additional photo copies of your passport: leave one at home with your emergency contact while keeping the other with you on the trip, separate from your actual passport (this will assist you at the embassy in the case of your passport being declared lost or stolen).

AIRFARE:

For your convenience, we offer airfare for purchase with all tour packages. This includes roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers via coach bus. This is an air inclusive tour package which means your airfare is quoted inclusive of all fuel, taxes, and fees. When traveling with group air, the air carrier for your flight will be announced in your final travel documents. Your rates are subject to change until paid in full. Due to the airlines restrictive group reservation terms, group airfare reservations are often difficult to coordinate. Seats are limited and may not be available on every flight or departure date. The number of connecting flights, length of layovers, and all conditions of air travel cannot be guaranteed and may change before departure. We ask you to be reasonably flexible. For seat requests, please note that group seats are assigned at the discretion of the airline. Specific seat requests cannot be guaranteed. If you require specific seats, OC Travel suggests you book the tour package as "land-only" and arrange for your own air travel.

LAND-ONLY PACKAGE:

If you wish to purchase your own airfare, you may wish to consider purchasing a land-only package. With this option, you are able to secure your own preferred air arrangements. The itinerary presented is tentative and subject to change. It represents what we are planning for you. However, it is subject to confirmations from many organizations. Because of changes in local schedules, we may need to alter specified events, dates, or venues, to better fit the overall plan. OC Travel reserves the right to alter or cancel the itinerary, at OC Travel services' sole discretion, as it deems necessary for the comfort, convenience, or the safety of the tour.

LUGGAGE:

Baggage is at owner's risk throughout the tour. Checked baggage is limited to ONE bag per person. Details will be in your final travel documents. For most airlines, the one checked bag is limited to 50 pounds and 62 inches (length + width + height). You may also bring a small carry-on bag that will fit under or above your airline seat and later in the coach bus. We recommend for this carry-on bag to be soft sided; about 8 inches high by 18 inches deep.

DRESS CODE:

Our journeys focus on the needs of our faith-based travelers. In visiting world famous spiritual sites, take note - there is often a dress code. Covering of knees and shoulders is required. Absolutely no shorts or shoulderless tops are permitted in the Vatican Museums, "Scavi" Tour or St. Peter's Basilica.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

This tour includes a significant amount of walking. Moderate physical activity is expected on a walking tour. This includes stairs and uneven walking surfaces. Motor coaches are often not permitted to pick up or drop off in front of major attractions. Some of the most unique sightseeing includes accessing locations that restrict motor coaches, especially in historic city centres. Bring appropriate walking shoes. Travelers must be medically and physically fit. The tour is not wheelchair accessible.

ROOMS:

Please note that single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first serve basis. Tour prices are per person according to a room type. A "single" room is one person in a room. A "double" is two persons in one room.

GRATUITIES:

Gratuities for your escort, driver and guides are included.

PARTICIPATION:
