## Planned Tentative Itinerary\*

### Monday, April 27, 2015 - Depart North America

Depart Vancouver on overnight flight to Rome, Italy.

### Tuesday, April 28, 2015 – Rome, Rapallo

Arrive in Rome, meet our Italian bus escort, and depart by private motor coach for the Italian Riviera. Arrival at our convent located in the resort town of Rapallo. Check in before the welcome dinner with local delicacies and fine Italian dessert. Overnight in Rapallo. (Dinner)

### Wednesday, April 29, 2015 – Rapallo, Turin

Enjoy the breathtaking city of Turin, one of the most elegant cities in Italy. Visit to Valdocco, the oasis for orphan children built by Don Bosco. See the tombs of both St. John Bosco and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati as well as the Shroud of Turin, what is believed to be the burial cloth of Christ. Free time to explore the pedestrian streets of this gorgeous city, which hosted the 2006 Olympic Winter Games. Enjoy the various cafes to taste the original local food and drink. Overnight in Rapallo.

### Thursday, April 30, 2015 – Rapallo, Milan

Take an excursion to Milan, world center of fashion and style. This famous city was the home of Sts. Ambrose, Augustine and Charles



Borromeo. See the famed Duomo and Galleria. Lunch in Milan before continuing through the countryside to Pavia, location of the tomb of St. Augustine. Overnight in Rapallo.

### Friday, May 1, 2015 – Rapallo, Rome

After breakfast, depart by motor coach for Rome. Check into convent. Lunch. Leisurely walking tour of city centre. Optional time for shopping in the neighborhood of the centro storico. Spectacular welcome dinner served with local food and Roman specialties. Overnight in Rome. (Dinner)

### Saturday, May 2, 2015 – Rome

In the morning, a private guided tour of Ancient Rome: explore the Roman Forum and Coliseum. See where the martyrs perished. Marvel at the genius of the ancients. Lunch. Enjoy some time at leisure to take in the sights and sounds of the neighborhood of ancient Rome. Take a stroll along the Tiber River. Get out and enjoy the city. Optional Rome by night walk at dusk: Trevi Fountain, Piazza Navona, Piazza Venezia, Spanish Steps, Campo de' Fiori. Overnight in Rome.

### Sunday, May 3, 2015 – Rome, Vatican City

Attend Sunday morning services in St. Peter's Basilica, the largest church in Christendom. At 12:00 noon the pope will appear from his bedroom window and greet the crowds while leading them in prayer. Lunch in the neighborhood of the Vatican. In the afternoon, open bus tour of religious sites in Rome: visits to the three major basilicas of Rome. St. Mary Major, the largest shrine in Rome dedicated to the Mother of Jesus. The Basilica of St. John Lateran, the cathedral church of Rome. Also, St. Paul's Outside-the-Walls, location of the tomb of St. Paul.

### Monday, May 4, 2015 – Rome, Vatican City

This morning, optional walk through the trendy neighborhood of Trastevere. See the ancient basilica located in the heart of this enchanting pocket of Rome. Lunch. This afternoon, enjoy the thrill of a private guided tour of the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel, where you will view some of the most inspiring works of art, including Michelangelo's magnificent fresco of the Last Judgement. Visit to St. Peter's Basilica. Overnight in Rome.



### Tuesday, May 5, 2015 – Rome

After breakfast, private guided tour at the Catacombs of St. Priscilla. This catacomb which occupies an area of countless acres, with a network of galleries, holds the oldest image of the Mother of Christ. Lunch. Explore the Villa Borghese Gardens.

### Wednesday, May 6, 2015 – Rome

Papal General Audience in St. Peter's Square. The pope addresses all present with a brief catechesis and all pray the Our Father together in Latin. Lunch in the neighborhood of the Vatican. Possible special guided tour of the Scavi necropolis - the excavations located below St. Peter's Basilica. See and pray before the tomb of St. Peter. Celebratory farewell dinner. Overnight in Rome. (Dinner)

### Thursday, May 7, 2015 – Depart Italy

This morning, transfer to Rome airport for return flights home.

For cancellation between 60-16 days prior to departure, cancellation fee of 30% of the total price. For cancellation between 15-1 days prior to departure, cancellation fee of 50% of total price. For cancellation on the day of departure and after, 100% of total price. Cancellation protection travel insurance is highly recommended and can be purchased at time of deposit.

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

##### PASSPORT:

A valid passport is required for this tour and must be in your possession at all times during the tour. If you do not have a passport, apply immediately as the process can entail a long wait. Remember to check the expiration date of your passport before booking (certain countries require a minimum of six months passport validity from the return date of your trip). At the time of reservation, OC Travel requires a copy of the inside page of your passport (showing your name and photo). Important: we recommend that you take two additional photo copies of your passport: leave one at home with your emergency contact while keeping the other with you on the trip, separate from your actual passport (this will assist you at the embassy in the case of your passport being declared lost or stolen).

##### AIRFARE:

For your convenience, we offer airfare for purchase with all tour packages. This includes roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers via coach bus. This is an air inclusive tour package which means your airfare is quoted inclusive of all fuel, taxes, and fees. When traveling with group air, the air carrier for your flight will be announced in your final travel documents. Your rates are subject to change until paid in full. Due to the airlines restrictive group reservation terms, group airfare reservations are often difficult to coordinate. Seats are limited and may not be available on every flight or departure date. The number of connecting flights, length of layovers, and all conditions of air travel cannot be guaranteed and may change before departure. We ask you to be reasonably flexible. For seat requests, please note that group seats are assigned at the discretion of the airline. Specific seat requests cannot be guaranteed. If you require specific seats, OC Travel suggests you book the tour package as "land-only" and arrange for your own air travel.

##### LAND-ONLY PACKAGE:

##### LUGGAGE:

You may also bring a small carry-on bag that will fit under or above your airline seat and later in the coach bus. You must be able to carry your own luggage. We recommend luggage on wheels.

##### DRESS CODE:

Our journeys focus on the needs of our faith-based travelers. In visiting world famous spiritual sites, take note - there is often a dress code. Covering of knees and shoulders is required. Absolutely no shorts or shoulderless tops are permitted in the Vatican Museums, "Scavi" Tour or St. Peter's Basilica.

##### HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

This tour includes a significant amount of walking. Moderate physical activity is expected on a walking tour. This includes stairs and uneven walking surfaces. Motor coaches are often not permitted to pick up or drop off in front of major attractions. Some of the most unique sightseeing includes accessing locations that restrict motor coaches, especially in historic city centres. Bring appropriate walking shoes. Travelers must be medically and physically fit. The tour is not wheelchair accessible.

##### ROOMS:

Please note that single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first serve basis. Tour prices are per person according to a room type. A "single" room is one person in a room. A "double" is two persons in one room.

##### PARTICIPATION:
